Face Up to the Disability Crisis in GE2020



People with disabilities are invisible in today's Ireland. We have the highest percentage of people with a disability at risk of poverty in Western Europe, 38%.¹ All parts of government must respond to these shocking facts.



A crisis ignored:

- Poverty rates for people with disabilities have doubled since 2011.²
- 22% of people with disability are in work, compared to 61% overall.³
- Disability services are crumbling, with mounting deficits of €40 million+.
- There are 643,131 people with disability in Ireland, 13.5% of the population.⁴
- By 2026, the number of people with disability will have increased by around 20%.5
- 85% of people with disabilities between 18 and 65 acquire their disability.6

Candidates:

1. End Disability Poverty

Disability and poverty have become inextricably bound. To address poverty and unemployment introduce;

- A payment for extra costs of disability in 2020.
- An assistive technology passport, at a cost of €1.5 million.
- An education, training and employment support fund, 2020-24.

2. End isolation for people with disabilities

Invest in wellbeing, instead of crisis intervention. €211 million p.a over 5 years on services to keep people with disabilities out of nursing homes, residential institutions and A&E.

- Invest €128 million in housing supports and adaptations in 2020.
- Commit 7.5% of social housing to accessible housing for people with disabilities.
- Establish a transport support scheme.

3. Show Leadership

- · Taoiseach's Department to lead on disability.
- Establish a Joint Oireachtas Committee on implementing the United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities, UN CRPD.
- Resolve the growing deficits of €40 million+ across disability services.
