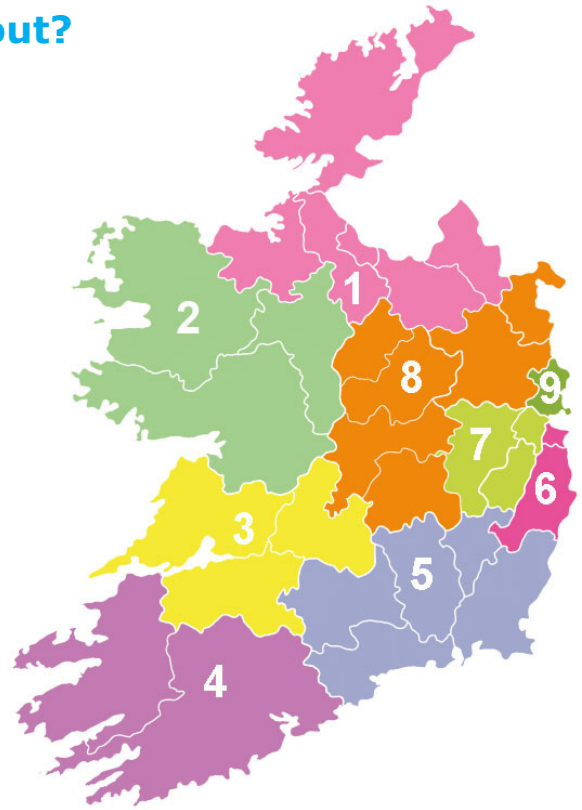


The Neuro-Mapping Project - Phase 2: Working together towards integrated care in the community, for adults with neuro rehabilitative needs.

What is the neuro mapping project about?

- Phase 2 of the Neuro-Mapping Project builds on the report and outputs of the first phase of the Neuro-Mapping project.
- Specifically, Phase 2 aims to further understand the current service and support pathways that occur between existing and developing community-services for adults with Neuro-rehabilitative needs in CHO 2, 3 and 6 by engaging with service users and service providers.



Why is the project taking place?

The purpose of the neuro-mapping project is to inform how services can provide a more streamlined journey for those with neuro-rehabilitative needs. This project will inform the work of the newly established HSE Community Workstream under the National Neuro-Rehabilitation Strategy. The role of this Workstream is to plan how neurorehabilitation services can be integrated with existing community services to improve the patient journey for individuals requiring neuro-rehabilitation.

Why we need your input?

Your insights, wisdom and experience are key to finding out what is happening with regard to service delivery and pathways for people living with neuro rehabilitative needs in the community. We know from Phase 1 of the project that there are some great examples of collaborative practice, and we know you have ideas about how services can improve. This is your chance to share your views and inform service planning. We are also holding a session with service users, and we would be delighted if you could help identify people living with neurological conditions with neuro-rehabilitative needs who would be interested in engaging with this project.



What's going to happen next

In early 2024 we will be carrying out briefing sessions and workshops with service users and service providers in CHO 3, and we will then continue our engagement in CHO 2 & 6.
