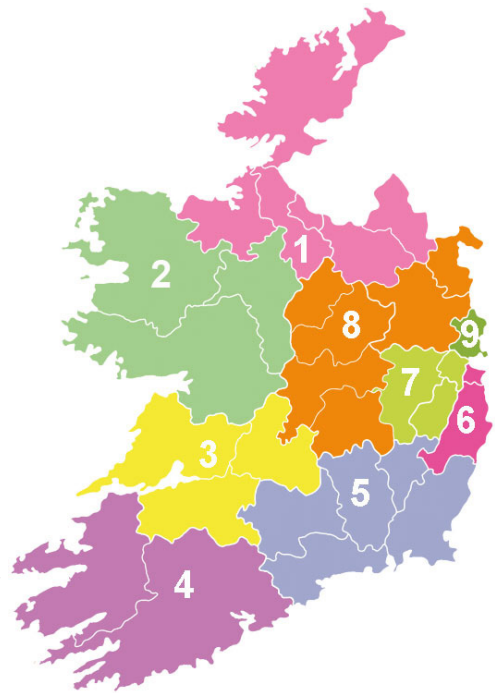


The Neuro-Mapping Project - Phase 2: Working together towards integrated care in the community, for adults with neuro rehabilitative needs.

Information leaflet for people accessing services in CHO 3

What is the neuro mapping project about?

- Many organisations provide neuro-rehabilitation services in the community to those living with neurological conditions.
- We would like to know what you think works well and what could be done to improve services.
- We will be carrying this work out in the following 3 HSE Community Health Organisations' regions
 - CHO 2 - Mayo, Roscommon, Galway
 - CHO 3 - Clare, Limerick, North Tipperary
 - CHO 6 - Wicklow, Dublin Southeast



Why is the project taking place?

- We want to find out how community services can work better together for those with neuro-rehabilitative needs.
- This project will inform the work of the newly established HSE Community Workstream under the National Neuro-Rehabilitation Strategy. The role of this Workstream is to plan how neuro-rehabilitation services can be integrated with existing community services to improve the patient journey for individuals requiring neuro-rehabilitation.

Why we need your input?

Hearing your voice and the insights of people who have experience of Neurorehabilitation Services is essential in delivering high quality services that meet your/people's needs.

We will be putting in place accessibility options and measures to ensure that all those that attend will be able to participate in the sessions and have their voice heard.
